

New Eagle Functionality

Eagle announces general availability on QAD 2016EE

As part of our continuing investment in to RF Express for QAD EA, Eagle is to announce RF Express's compatibility with QAD Enterprise Applications 2016EE. The new QAD release has already been delivered to a number of Eagle's major manufacturing customers and we are encouraging our other valued customers to look at the latest QAD upgrade.

The RF Express upgrade to QAD 2016EE can be delivered as part of existing customers' maintenance contracts, either on premise or in the QAD cloud. Eagle encourage all of our customers to upgrade to the latest QAD version.

New Eagle Transactions

Lot Status Change: Lot Status Change will allow the user to change the status of a particular lot across multiple locations. This is applicable for any of our customers using QAD's lot functionality. A lot/batch may have been received and a quantity of this batch moved to

a separate location for QC testing - and thus the whole batch would be on hold. This transaction will allow the batch to be released in all locations at the end of the QC process.

Alternatively, there may be a situation where a batch needs to be placed on hold, which could be in multiple locations or pallets. Previously each inventory record would have to be updated but this can now be done with a single transaction using RF Express.

Blind Tag Count: Eagle has added new functionality to help increase the flexibility and efficiency of a full physical stock take. With the complexities that may arise during stock count, the process may be long and inefficient. In conjunction with our partner IT Dynamics, we have created a new Blind Tag Count program to overcome these issues. Read more here.

vLock: Lot Eagle has added new functionality to help our customers analyse locks within RF Express and QAD. By enabling this new function, the user can see all locks in the QAD system affecting a specific function. This helps track down users who may have left their QAD session in the middle of a transaction, thereby affecting their colleagues ability to perform transactions. This is available in versions 2015 onwards.

Staged Pick and Ship: Eagle has developed a whole new suite of programs added to RF Express for QAD for the handling, staging and shipments of goods. As part of this development, Eagle has incorporated enhanced functionality for the specific control of serial controlled items in picking and shipping.
